	<p>Arci Solidarietà ONLUS is a center of non-profit associative life, independent, pluralist, non-partisan, democratic and progressist. Arci Solidarietà Onlus is located and operates in Rome, the Italian capital city. In the last 15 years immigration remarkably increased and the social conditions in Roma Camps keep being a dramatic unicum in Europe.</p> <p>This context made it necessary to start a pioneering process of dissemination of good practices with public authorities respecting the different levels/kinds of responsibility (districts, Municipalities, Metropolitan City, the Public Health Centres) and citizens interested by this phenomenon, becoming a key-reference on social issues.</p> <p>Through our projects, services, collaborations and events, the association adquired a sound experience in different areas of intervention: Roma and Immigration; Youth and Childhood; Social inclusion and citizenship.</p>
